Key Responsibilities:

- Safely operate the DACIC electric vehicle to transport community members to and from various destinations within the Dornoch area.
- Ensure the vehicle is well-maintained, clean, and charged.
- Provide friendly and courteous service to all passengers.
- Maintain accurate records of trips, mileage, and any incidents or issues.
- Adhere to all traffic laws and regulations, as well as DACIC's policies and procedures.
- Communicate any vehicle maintenance or safety concerns to DACIC staff promptly.

Skills & Requirements:

- A valid UK driving license with a clean driving record.
- Experience driving electric vehicles is an asset but not required; training will be provided.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Reliable, punctual, and able to commit to a regular schedule.
- A strong sense of responsibility and commitment to community service.
- Ability to handle confidential information with discretion.
- Successful applicants will need to acquire a Protection of Vulnerable Groups (PVG) certificate. DACIC will assist with the application process for the PVG scheme.
